- Briefly discussed the ad-hoc Education Management Organization Search Committee meetings regarding the proposals from American Paradigm Schools and String Theory Schools
 The committee has formed a recommendation in favor of String Theory
- The committee was comprised of five board members and five faculty members, including Ms. Barnett, and its recommendation was unanimous

C. CEO

Jacqueline Barnett

- The ACE Report answers from CHAD have been uploaded to Google Drive for the Board's review
- The current focus for CHAD is Keystone metrics
 - The Board reviewed Part 4 of the Spreadsheets, which pertains to standards that CHAD and every school must meet
 - CHAD corrected some variances in the data presented by the School District
- The Administration is anticipating an upward trend in Keystone scores this year
- Amber Fisher Brown has been meeting with Keystone topic teachers on a weekly basis to make sure goals are clear
 - She has been speaking with 9th grade teachers in order to streamline content so next year's 10th graders are better prepared for Keystones
 - She will also push in to Keystone topic classes to help where it is needed
- CHAD is supporting bottom third of students with tutoring
- CHAD is issuing more parent communication regarding Keystones for Title I compliance
- Administration anticipates that college matriculation will increase
- Data & Assessments
 - o Link-It: provides visualized way of linking keystone questions to curriculum to students
 - Can use it to see real-time where students are in proficiency—CHAD is looking into obtaining a free pilot

D. Business Controller

- January's report uploaded to Google Drive for the Board's review
- School's Subsidy:
 - Budgeted for 610; 105 of which are Special Ed
- Expenses:
 - Savings in salaries and benefits, which is counteracted by increase in professional services
 - Rent: LA Liberty needs an additional 100k in rental income to survive, which is paid by CHAD
- CHAD reported a net income of 245k through January

- The current cash on hand is 764K (35 days); CHAD is required to have 45 days of cash on hand _ by bondholders
- Food service operating at 11k loss through December, which is consistent -
- 480K in disbursements for January
- Cashflow: _
 - Adding increase of SPED students each month to achieve final amount 0
 - At the end of the fiscal year, CHAD is projected to have about 600K in cash (30 days 0 cash on hand)
 - Currently CHAD is at half of what last year's cashflow projection was
